The Ethiopian Eunuch

- 30 So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?"
- 31 And he said, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" And he asked Philip to come up and sit with him.

The Word of God is often compared to food in the Scriptures

Deuteronomy 8:3

3 So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every *word* that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.

The Bible Is A Living Organism

- “The Bible is alive, it speaks to me; it has feet, it runs after me; it has hands, it lays hold of me. The Bible is not antique or modern. It is eternal.” (Martin Luther)
- “For the word of God *is* living and powerful....” Hebrews 4:12



Opening The Door To God's Word

- **Exegesis: Reading out of Scriptures and letting Scripture speak for itself within its context**
- **Exegesis unlocks the door to God's word**



Opening The Door To The Fallible Ideas And Theories Of Man

- Eisegesis= Interpreting Scripture according one's own ideas, i.e. reading into the Bible with our own opinion
- Eisegesis unlocks the door to man's ideas



The subject of the Bible is Jesus and His redemptive work

- "You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me." ---John 5:39
- "Then He said to them, "These *are* the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and *the* Prophets and *the* Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures." ---Luke 24:44-45

The Main Themes In The Bible

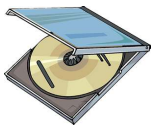
- Protection: God protects man
